CIP - Highlights

- The teachers will utilize real time data from technology programs to make instructional decisions to meet the students' specific learning needs (ex. IXL, Study Island, and Accelerated Reader).
- Hook will implement NWEA Maps Assessment as the Universal Screener for 3rd and 4th Grade in the areas of Math, Reading, Language Usage, and Science. This assessment will be given three times a year.
- Implement Guided Math program that allows the teacher to work with students in small groups based on their individual needs.
- Provide daily face-to-face support to capitalize on research-based practices, embedding and integrating technology
- Data will be disaggregated after each Unit Assessment to address areas of strength and weakness. The content teams from both third and fourth will meet together
- Students will take ownership of their learning by charting and monitoring their progress using a Champion Performance Plan. Content lessons will be designed around the specific needs of the students based on this data.
- Student Conferencing will occur each six weeks where the student and the teacher discuss the academic growth of the student.
- TEKS Resources will be implemented in all areas as the curriculum scope and sequence.
- Unit Assessments will be given after each unit and tracked in Aware.
- Implementation of Empowering Writers will continue as we are seeing the direct benefits of this program.
- Academic Growth for all students will be a focus as well as specialized interventions for our students in the At-Risk and Hispanic sub populations.
