Following middle of year testing using TPRI, STAR Reading and CIRCLE tests, we met with teachers at each grade level to assign/update our Reading Tier assignments. All Tier 2 students will receive 30 minutes of pull-out support with Ms. Burns, Mrs. Martinez, or small group intervention with their classroom teacher. All Tier 3 students will receive 30 minutes of pull-out support with Mrs. Urbis or small group intervention with their classroom teacher. Mrs. Urbis or small group intervention with their classroom teacher. Mrs. Urbis will also provide Tier 3 in-class support to grades 4 and 5.

Using data from MOY, we have begun to update our Data-Informed Plan. We will examine goals set at BOY and revise goals based on current testing. Action steps set to accomplish these goals will be updated or modified for the upcoming semester. Targeted goals at each grade level include a focus on vocabulary and comprehension. We will also meet with Marlin EOAC teachers to update the Data-Informed Plan for their campus.

Joanna Oliver visited with TLI team leaders to discuss her role and how she could best serve the elementary campus. Joanna is a TLI consultant with the Institute for Public School Initiatives (IPSI), a part of the University Of Texas College Of Education. She is scheduled to visit our campus on a weekly/biweekly basis to provide professional development on best teaching practices, as well as support and feedback to teachers.
