

Glacier County Interdisciplinary Child Information and School Safety Team Rules

- 1) This team operates under the confidentiality outlines in §41-3-205, MCA.
- 2) This team maintains a membership as per §52-2-211, MCA. This team may add members as allowed by law that the team deems necessary, to further the safety and wellbeing of the students of Glacier County.
- 3) This team meets monthly, on the third Wednesday of the month at 2:00 PM in county annex conference room; however, not in the summer months unless requested by team member(s).
- 4) The leadership of the team will be as follows with terms from October-September:

Following years will rotate with those serving as secretary Chair serving as secretary in the next term.

Year 2: Cut Bank

Year 3 East Glacier

Year 4 Mountain View

- 4) Team meeting attendance kept via sign in sheet.
- 5) The team members may take notes for reference in keeping actions, solutions, and assistance of students moving forward, but the team shall not keep minutes. These notes shall be maintained by the individual member in a secured location as Montana law requires.
- 6) The team understands that students are safest in school, where they are fed, dry, warm and in the presence of trained adult supervision. For that reason, the focus discussions may be, but are not limited to mental health and wellness, food insecurity, bullying, hygiene, truancy, violence, suicidal ideation, and physical health including dental and vision.
