

CALENDAR FOR TRUSTEE ELECTION
Saturday MAY 12, 2012

Two trustee places are up for election. Two 3-year terms currently filled by appointees Rick Alvarado (completing John Paul Schuster's term) and Donna Schuster (completing Mark Frerich's term). Candidate packets are available at the Brackett ISD Central Administration Office beginning Wednesday, February 1, 2012.

- 2/4/12** **First day to file for a place on the ballot.** (Saturday – but not required to be open)
- 3/5/12** **Last day to file for a place on the ballot: 5:00 p.m. deadline.** Last day to order general election to be held May 12, 2012.
- 3/6/2012 Conduct ballot position drawing.
First day an election may be cancelled if all filing deadlines have passed and each candidate for an office listed on the ballot is unopposed.
- 3/8/2012 Last day for a candidate to withdraw from election
- 3/13/12 First day to accept applications for early voting ballots by mail.
- 3/28/12 First day early voting clerk may begin mailing early voting ballots to applicants.
- 4/12/12 Last day to register to vote.
- 4/23/12 Last day to post Notice of Election.
- 4/27/12 Last day to notify election judges of duty to hold election (Writ of Election)
- 4/30/12** **First day to vote early in person: 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.**
- 5/4/12 Last day to receive an application for a ballot to be voted by mail.
- 5/8/12** **Last day to vote early by personal appearance; 5:00 p.m. deadline**
- ELECTION DAY**
- 5/12/12** **7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. – Polls open at KC Courthouse.**
7:00 p.m. – Deadline for receiving early voting ballots by mail.
- 5/15/12 –** **Board of Trustees to canvas election: specific date to be determined.**
5/23/12 **(Post notice 72 hours before canvass.)**
- 5/17/12 Last day to receive carrier envelopes placed in the mail by 7:00 p.m. on election day, May 12, 2012, from voters who are voting outside the United States.
- 7/12/12 First day ballot box(es) may be unlocked and ballots transferred to secure container for remainder of preservation period.
- 11/13/12 Contents of ballot box(es) may be destroyed if no contest or criminal investigation has arisen.
