Section 504 - Students

In compliance with the requirements of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the district shall ensure that no otherwise qualified individual with disabilities shall, solely by reason of his/her disability, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity conducted by the district or those provided by the district through contractual or other arrangements. Programs and activities shall be accessible and usable by individuals with disabilities as prescribed by law.

The superintendent will ensure all Section 504 qualified students with disabilities are identified annually. Students will be evaluated by a team of individuals knowledgeable about the student, the meaning of the evaluation data and placement options. Services will be provided as required by law.

The Board directs the superintendent to ensure procedures for the implementation of programs and activities are developed to conform with the requirements of state and federal law. Such procedures will be retained in the Three Rivers School District Special Education Manual, Vol.2.
