Board President: The Board of Trustees may conduct a closed or executive meeting or session under the Texas Open Meetings act, Government Code, Chapter 551, Subchapters D and E. Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the section or sections of the Act authorizing the closed meeting. All final votes, actions, or decisions will be taken in an open meeting. The Board of Trustees may convene in closed or executive session or meeting as authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, under the following Texas Government Code Sections:

- **§551.071** Private consultation with the Board's attorney on any or all subjects or matters authorized by law including board governance.
