This is an opportunity for resident, business and property owners, parents/guardians, students and employees of the Red Wing School District to address the board. We ask that you adhere to the guidelines set in place by District Policy 206 regarding public comment.

This is a listening opportunity for the board and not a time to debate an issue. You are prohibited from making comments about specific students, staff or administrators. The board respects and values input from the pubic, but when it relates to a specific student, staff or administrator, such input must be heard by the appropriate personnel such as the building principal or superintendent, and not during an open meeting of the school board. We require that you limit your remarks to three minutes. You are not allowed to yield your time to another person. It is expected that members of the public will address their remarks with civility and respect.

You will address the board from the public comment table. After being recognized by the board chair, identify yourself and the group you represent, if any. <u>Please state your reason for</u> <u>addressing the board</u>.

The board may allot up to twenty total minutes at each regular school board meeting for public comment. Public comment is not available at workshops or closed sessions of the school board.
