### **BACKGROUND:**

The Brownsville ISD received the ADSY Pep grant Cycle 5 in the amount of \$200,000.00. The grant agreement is in cooperation between Communities Foundation of Texas, Educate Texas in coordination with the Texas Education Agency to the Brownsville Independent School District. This grant serves to assist the district to engage in a year-long planning process to implement high quality, evidence-based summer learning programs with the ultimate outcome of developing a culture and climate that impacts student academic achievement and a love of learning through both academic and enrichment opportunities. During the 2025 summer program, ADSY PEP will serve 1<sup>st</sup> graders attending 5 campuses (Del Castillo-Morningside, Cromack-Castañeda, Palm Grove, El Jardin, Garza at Southmost) at 2 summer sites (Del Castillo-Morningside, Cromack-Castañeda). The program will run a total of 25 days with a minimum of six hours of instruction. Three hours concentrating in reading and math and with the rest of the day focusing on instructional enrichment activities.

## **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:**

Summer of 2025 funding for this initiative will be utilized in coordination with the current summer program funding sources utilized by the district (State Compensatory and Federal Funds). Continuation of the grant for subsequent years is dependent on TEA funding.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Recommend approval to utilize the ADSY Pep grant Cycle 5 grant funds in accordance to the Memorandum of Understanding as submitted to TEA and was board approved on 1/14/2025 for the 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 (pending grant funding) school year.
