School Board Goals 2013-14

- 90% of high school seniors will apply to a post secondary institution or the military.

- The school district will achieve a fund balance of 8% of the unassigned general fund by fiscal year 2023.
 - In progress. The approved budget FY 14 budget projects the unassigned general fund budget to be 3.1% in comparison to 2.4% last year.
