TOPIC:Resolution to Call a Special Election on August 5, 2014 for
Operating and Sinking Fund Millage Renewals

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District call for an election on August 5, 2014, and adopt the attached resolution for millage renewal proposals.

RATIONALE:

Under current state law, the Livonia Public Schools must seek renewal of the existing General Operating millage set to expire in 2015 and the existing Sinking Fund set to expire 2014 in order to keep its current level of funding. In order to obtain the total per pupil foundation grant as allowed by the state, the district seeks a renewal of 18.4568 mills on non-homestead property in the school. The district is also seeking to renew 1.12 mills property tax on all property in the district set to expire in 2014 for the specific purpose of construction, remodeling, repair (and all other purposes authorized by law) of its school buildings and sites.
