AEF investments funds managed by



- Within the endowment there are four distinct "buckets"
 - General \$733,740.00 establishing a perpetual income stream that we began drawing upon in 2014
 - Liza M-Z Restricted \$29,723.00 provides funding for the \$1,000 Annual Golden Eagle Teacher Excellence Award
 - Cantrell Restricted \$10,496.00 provides funding for annual health sciences student scholarship
 - CoServ Electric Teacher Assistance \$155,500.00 provides additional funding for the teacher grants
