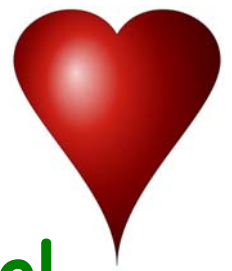

Hello Evergreen Friends and Family,

As spring approaches, many of our classrooms are beginning to take some field trips and have class activities that may require parent involvement. Examples: Set limits on TV watching, checking in with kids when parents are not home, arranging after-school activities and supervised care

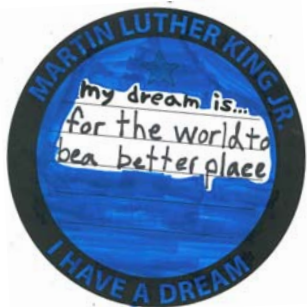



Child Find for Special Education

Public Law 105.17, known as the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children and young adults from birth through 21 years of age.
