**LINK: Life skills, independence, networking and knowledge
for adults with disabilities.**

Creative Activities:

Seasonal events such as a hayride at Bunker Hills and a Halloween Costume Party are offered alongside cooking classes, art activities, trips to sporting events, and movies and dinners at local theaters and restaurants.

Staff members talk regularly with program participants and work to provide activities and events that are appealing to them.



Caring Staff:

Community Education staff members know each LINK participant personally. Staff members are aware of participants' physical and cognitive abilities which allow them to adapt activities to ensure that each person has the opportunity to participate.

The LINK program provides opportunities for adults with disabilities to gain knowledge, improve skills and participate in social activities.

- An average of 15 adults participated in each activity.
