Building Updates (added or removed)

1. Gator Expansion Project:

- ➤ The project commences with the renovation of the One Main building 5th floor. Phase 1 work is scheduled to start December 2024.
- ➤ Phase 2 of the project is the addition of a 4th floor to the Girard Street building (36,000 sq/ft) Phase 2 work is scheduled to start July 2025.
- 2. Major progress on the One Main Building elevator modernization project.
- 3. Continue to address planned/deferred maintenance as per the Life Cycle Index.

Land Purchases or Boundary Updates (added or removed)

- > UHD at 1801 Main Street: 10th floor (17,000sq/ft.) of Amegy Bank Build.
- ➤ UHD/UHS working with TxDOT to finalize the North Houston Highway Improvement Project MOU.
- ➤ North Canal Project: Start Summer 2026 to Complete Winter 2029


Landscape, Art or Misc. Updates (added or removed)
