If the Raise the Cap Amendment were in place today, students in Davis School District would have received an estimated \$11.57 million in School LAND Trust Funds rather than \$10.24 million for the 2024-2025 school year.

Statewide, Utah students would have received \$120 million instead of \$106 million.

This November, Utahns will vote on a constitutional amendment to increase the cap on distributions from the Permanent State School Fund from 4% to 5%.

- Raising the cap costs taxpayers nothing, it simply increases the percentage of LAND Trust distributions schools may receive from the Permanent State School Fund.
- This constitutional amendment aims to create more balanced distributions from the Permanent School Fund for current and future school children.
- Established at statehood, the Permanent School Fund tops \$3.3 billion. This perpetual endowment provides funding for critical academic needs identified by each School Community Council.
- This amendment is NOT related to another proposed amendment dealing with an earmark on income tax funding for public education.

Money earned by the Trust Lands Administration from school trust lands is invested by the School and Institutional Trust Funds Office.
