

School attendance boundaries shall be established by the Board upon recommendation of the Superintendent. A student shall be assigned to a school in the attendance area in which he or she resides.

If school boundaries change, the Board delegates to the Superintendent or designee the authority to determine rules on grandfathering of current students, transportation of grandfathered students, sibling requests, and other related matters. [See FDB Regulation]. A transfer may be granted under circumstances outlined in approved intradistrict transfer administrative procedures [FDB Regulation].

### Class Changes

The campus principal shall be authorized to investigate and approve the transfer of a student from one classroom to another on that campus.

### Transfers Between Schools

The Superintendent or designee shall be authorized to investigate and approve transfers between schools.

The District's Hurricane Harvey Guarantee, as set forth more fully in FDB (Regulation), applies to displaced nonresident students/families who were residents on August 25, 2017 and who submitted the required paperwork by June 1, 2018.

All transfer students are subject to existing UIL eligibility requirements.

Transfers are not granted to schools/grade levels considered at capacity, when space is not available in a specific program on a campus, and/or to any campus requiring an application including but not limited to dual language programs, SBAI, WAIS, Academy of Choice, and Cornerstone.

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**Note:** For the transfer of a student who is the victim of bullying or who engaged in bullying, see FDB(LEGAL). For the
