# Some EF Rules and Teacher Rules for safety and comfort of our group:

- -Teachers and EF director will accompany travelers at all times. We do all activities together, accompany students at the airport, through security and customs check points, fly together, stay in same hotel with rooms adjacent to each other, eat at the same restaurants, etc.
- -At NO time are students allowed to go anywhere by themselves. Travelers will be accountable for their buddy or group. All will be accounted for several times daily- to be sure all are present, safe and healthy. The bus will not leave until all travelers are present.
- -There are NO water activities planned on this trip.
- -Teachers will have a system for safeguarding passports; a first aid kit; students are provided with emergency phone numbers of teachers and EF tour director.
- -Teachers will NOT give rides to students in their private cars. Students/parents must make their own arrangements to transport to and from home.
- Denton ISD rules of conduct and dress code will be expected of all travelers.
- -Ground transportation in Spain will be by private bus- arranged by EF tour director.
- -Overnight accommodations and breakfast and dinner meals are arranged by EF tour director. Lunches are on our own in the towns where we are visiting. Travelers will choose their own lunch meals and will pay for these with their own money- separate from the tour price.
- -Male students room with male students (4 to a room).
- -Female students room with female students (4 to a room).
- -Adults room with other adults (2 to a room) or pay extra for single rooms.

- Visit the Alhambra, Granada's crowning jewel that's widely recognized as the world's premier example of Moorish architecture. Built as an all-in-one alcazaba (fortress), alcazar (palace) and small medina (city), the Alhambra was home to the last of the Nasrid Sultans. Elaborately embellished in the 14th century and surrounded by lush green trees, it was described by Moorish poets as "a pearl set in emeralds." See the exotic mosaics, fountains, latticed windows, arabesques, and ornamented courtyards that made this vast stronghold worthy of royal occupancy. Here, King Ferdinand and Queen Isabella agreed to finance the historic voyage of Christopher Columbus
- Travel to Seville.

# Day 7: Seville | Costa del Sol

- Today you will explore Seville, city of bullfights, flamenco dancing, Don Juan and Carmen, and the heartbeat of Andalusian culture. During your stay you can follow narrow, twisting alleys through the Barrio de Santa Cruz, where picturesque whitewashed houses, flowerfilled patios, and tiled benches are pleasant reminders of an unhurried lifestyle. Pass by Maria Louisa Park to admire the mosaics and fountains of Plaza de España, centerpiece of the 1929 Ibero-American Fair. Visit the grave of Christopher Columbus inside Seville's Cathedral. And imagine the spectacle of a traditional Spanish bullflight at the Plaza de Toros, celebrated for its Baroque architecture and historical significance.

- Visit the Seville Cathedral.
- Take a walking tour of Seville.
- Travel to the Costa del Sol.
