Food Service Summer Update

We would like to provide a brief update on current and upcoming Food Service Department programs.

Our Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) will run June 22 through August 21 and provides free meals to all children ages 1–18 regardless of income. This year, the program will operate as a non-congregate, weekly bulk meal pick-up model. Each child will receive five breakfasts and lunches, along with milk, fruits, juice, and vegetables to support meal access throughout the week. We currently have approximately 360 children enrolled.

Meal distribution sites include North Bend High School, Hauser, and Lakeside. In addition, we will continue to serve hot, ready-to-eat meals for students participating in Boys & Girls Club programs and District summer enrichment programs.

Looking ahead to next school year, the District has been approved for the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), allowing all students in all four schools to receive breakfast and lunch at no charge. We will also continue participation in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) supper program for the Boys & Girls Club, and are working to expand this program to include Kingsview Christian School's after-school program, pending final program requirements.

We also recognize and honor several long-serving Food Service staff members who will be retiring this year: Judy Johnson (1999), Dani Johnson (2002), Sherry Branton-Hall (2004), and Jean Ivans (1991). Together, they have served the District for decades and have supported generations of students through our meal programs. We extend our sincere appreciation for their service and wish them the very best in retirement.

We are currently in the process of hiring and onboarding staff to fill these positions and look forward to a successful start to the upcoming school year.
