Application for Recorded Texas Historic Landmark - Calhoun M.S.

SUMMARY:

- This item requests approval to pursue application for Calhoun Middle School Main Building, formerly Denton Senior High (1924-1957) as a Recorded Texas Historic Landmark (RTHL).

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

- This item was discussed with the Board during the workshop session January 8, 2007.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The Texas Historical Commission RTHL designation is awarded to historic structures deemed worthy of preservation for their architectural integrity and historical associations. This designation is the highest honor the state can bestow on historic structures (Texas Historical Commission brochure).

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

- The designation addresses the exterior features of the building only and does not deal with interior arrangement of spaces.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

- \$1,600.00

- Cost of action over 1 years is estimated to be \$1,600.00
- Costs will be borne by appropriated district funds.

- Ad valorem tax exemptions, if granted by local taxing authorities
- Eligibility for state preservation grant funds

- Technical preservation assistance through the THC

PROCEDURAL AND REPORTING IMPLICATIONS:

- The district would be restricted from doing any exterior modifications without first notifying the Texas Historical Commission in writing 60 days prior.
