Addendum #2 to Texas A&M International University and Eagle Pass Independent School District Memorandum of Understanding for a Dual Credit Relationship

WHEREAS, Texas A&M International University (TAMIU) and Eagle Pass Independent School District (EPISD) have an existing Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) outlining the instructional relationship pertaining to the provision of Dual Credit college courses as mandated by House Bill 1 of the 79th Texas Legislature;

WHEREAS, both TAMIU and EPISD remain willing and able to participate in the facilitation of this MOU to the benefit of the parties and students;

NOW, THEREFORE, the existing MOU is amended as follows:

Section 1) Dual Credit Courses, subsection (a) will read:

Dual credit courses are courses in which a high school student enrolls in a college course and receives simultaneous academic credit for both the college and high school course. Courses offered for dual credit must be identified by TAMIU as college level academic courses. The courses to be offered are:

PSYC 2301 Introduction to Psychology COMM 1311 Fundamentals of Communication

Section 1) Dual Credit Courses, subsection (b) will read:

TAMIU will teach dual credit course sections in accordance with TAMIU's enrollment guidelines. The guidelines are as follows: PSYC 2301: Minimum of 25 students

COMM 1311 Minimum of 25 students; maximum of 30 students

Section 2) Eligibility (a) will read: High school students must demonstrate eligibility to enroll in dual credit courses in the eleventh and/or twelfth grade by meeting (1) Texas Success Initiative and dual credit standards; (2) TAMIU's course placement requirements; and (3) overall high school grade average of 85.

Section 12) Terms of Agreement, subsection (a), will read:

This MOU will be in effect through <u>August 31, 2014</u>. The parties may mutually agree to renew the MOU for successive one (1) year terms following the amended term.

All other terms and stipulations as stated in the original Memorandum of Understanding and in Addendum #1 shall remain in effect and binding.

This addendum shall become effective upon approval by TAMIU and EPISD.
