## 1 – Finance Committee; Mrs. Johnson, Chair

Mrs. Johnson, Committee Chair, will provide board members with a recap of the January 22, 2014 Finance Committee Meeting.

## a. 2013-14 Student Fees

**Information** 

At the January 22, 2014 Finance Committee, the Committee members and the Administration were in consensus to bring the below 2014-15 student fees to the February 4, 2014 Board of Education Meeting.

The recommendations for 2014-15 fees are:

- Student fees remain the same at \$110 for K-5 students and \$140 for 6-8 students.
- Technology fees increase \$5 from \$30 to \$35 per student.
- Lunch prices will increase by \$.05 from \$2.60 to \$2.65, enhanced lunch will increase \$.20 from \$3.00 to \$3.20, breakfast will remain the same at \$1.50 and milk will remain the same at \$.50.
- Transportation fees will increase \$10 from \$175 to \$185 for the first student in the family and remain the same at \$150 per student for additional students in the same family. These charges are for all students riding the bus including St. Emily students. This is a cost of less than \$1.00 per day or \$.50 per ride.
- Increase preschool fees for typical students from \$2,250 to \$2,350. The snack fee of \$50 for a district provided snack for all students (typical and special needs) not qualifying for free or reduced lunch will remain the same.
