## COMPENSATORY EDUCATION: TITLE I PROGRAM

The Tupelo Public School District Title I Program will:

- 1. Convene annually a public meeting during the second semester to which all parents of Title I students, parents of non-Title I students, Title I staff, teachers and administrators will be invited to discuss the Title I program. The discussion will include informing parents of their rights in the planning and implementation of the Title I project. Further, it will solicit parents' input and will provide parents an opportunity to establish mechanisms for maintaining ongoing communications among parents, teachers, and Title I officials.
- 2. Notify parents in a timely manner that their child has been selected to participate in a Title I program and why the child was selected.
- Notify parents in writing or in a student handbook of the daily scheduled time for conferences. At such time the parent will be informed of the specific instructional objectives for the child.
- 4. Send parents progress reports each grading period as well as regular report eards from teachers to parents throughout the school year.
- 5. Inform parents at the annual public meeting, or upon request, information of the overall progress or evaluation of the Title I program.
- 6. Respond in a timely manner to all recommendations received from parents.
- 7. Have a Title I parent representative from each target school.
- 8. Provide at least two parent meetings for parental input into the Title I program.
