About Skyward

Since 1980, Skyward has been used by more than 2,500 school districts. Their enterprise resource planning (ERP) software stores budgetary and employment data, all the while streamlining essential business processes.

In 2014 Skyward began developing Qmlativ, an innovative software program that boasted their most advanced ERP technology yet.

District 70

D70 began using Skyward in 2005. For the next 20 years the district processed payroll using Skyward's point and click (PAC) software. In recent years, accounts payable, purchasing and bookkeeping transitioned to Skyward's first iteration of a webbased software (SMS 2.0). However, neither version was user friendly and the technology was outdated.

When Stacey Bachar joined D70 in 2023 as the CSBO and Assistant Superintendent of Finance and Operations, she heard her team's frustrations with the outdated software. There was a clear need for an innovative platform that was easier to use, had more functionality and could keep up with evolving business and technology practices. With support from district leadership and the Board of Education, the decision to migrate to Qmlativ was made.

Enhanced Support

Skyward hosts a dynamic, self-service support website with an intelligent search capability that includes multimedia tutorials and interactive flowcharts. They also offer direct assistance via support tickets.

Continuing Education & Training

Skyward provides free monthly CE courses and has a full library of training videos. Annual conferences and other events are offered too.

- Setup, verify and test database
- Launch district-wide
