School Resource Officers	To implement the District's comprehensive safety programs, the District has entered into an agreement with a local law enforce- ment agency for school resource officers. School resource officers shall provide services consistent with the terms of the agreement, the comprehensive safety programs, and Board policy.
	A school resource officer shall perform duties as described in the agreement and as included in the District improvement plan and the Student Code of Conduct. A school resource officer shall not be assigned routine classroom discipline or administrative tasks.
School Marshals	Pursuant to its authority under state law, the Board may appoint an employee of the District to serve as a school marshal if the em- ployee is certified as eligible by the Texas Commission on Law En- forcement (TCOLE). [See CKEB(LEGAL)]
Training	All school resource officers <u>and employees serving as marshals</u> shall receive at least the minimum amount of education and train- ing required by law.
