SUBJECT: Purchase Over 50K – Software Subscription Renewal Memo No: SB25-196

#### **NSBSD Policy Manual:**

**BP 3300** Expenditures/Expending Authority: The Superintendent or designee may purchase supplies, materials, and equipment in accordance with the law. The Superintendent or designee shall not authorize any proposed expenditure that exceeds the major budget classification allowance against which the expenditure is the proper charge unless an amount sufficient to cover the purchase is available in the budget for transfer.

**BP 3310**, Purchasing Procedures: The School Board desires to ensure that maximum value is received for money spent by the district and that records are kept in accordance with the law. The Superintendent or designee may issue and sign purchase orders.

**BP 3311**, Bids: The district shall purchase equipment, supplies and services on a competitive bidding basis when required by law and whenever it appears to be in the best interest of the district to do so. All bids under federal awards must be made in accordance with the standards set forth in 2 CFR 200.320

**BP 3312**, Contracts: The Superintendent of designee may enter into contracts and memoranda of agreement (MOA's) on behalf of the District. All contracts and MOA's with a dollar value of \$50,000 or greater must be approved by the School Board.

**BP 3440**, Inventories: The Superintendent or designee shall provide for the proper control and conservation of district property.

#### **Issue Summary**

The North Slope Borough School District (NSBSD) is renewing its annual subscription with Jamf Software, LLC to maintain comprehensive Apple device management, cybersecurity, and safe internet access for all district-owned Mac and iOS devices. Jamf services are critical to safeguarding student technology, managing district assets, and ensuring safe online environments.





## **Background**

## Jamf Subscription Renewal:

Jamf is a core part of NSBSD's Apple device management strategy. It provides the district with essential services, including:

- Jamf Pro: Enterprise-level device management for Macs and iPads.
- Jamf Safe Internet: Student internet filtering and online protection.
- Jamf Protect EDU: Endpoint security tailored for education.
- Jamf Connect Basic: Single sign-on and streamlined authentication for users.

## **Length of Contract:**

This renewal covers services from July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026, for 1,466 student devices and 2,500 Mac-only devices, totaling \$64,953.20.

## **Compliance with BP 3311:**

Jamf qualifies as a **sole-source procurement** based on its unique integration with NSBSD's Apple ecosystem. Transitioning to a different provider would require significant reconfiguration, retraining, and could introduce security vulnerabilities. Continuing with Jamf ensures operational continuity and minimizes costs.

## Alignment with NSBSD Strategic Plan:

Renewing Jamf ensures continued efficiency in managing district-owned Apple devices, protects against cybersecurity threats, and maintains safe learning environments without incurring costs for retraining, reconfiguration, or migrating to a new solution.
