### Purpose of Partnership

- To supplement the current partnership with Laredo College to assist students who have not achieved "college readiness" standards.
- McMurry, a private institution does not require TSI to enroll in college courses.
- THECB allows IHE's(Laredo College) to accept successful completion of college-level coursework as a "college readiness" indicator.
- Laredo College and United ISD have reached an agreement to accept successful completion of History 1301 as a college readiness standard to continue their coursework towards their associates degree.

## Partnership Highlights


- Accredited by SACSCOC

- \$200 flat free for any course
- No books fees
- Asynchronous or Face to Face options available
- Works with UISD Adjuncts to deliver face to face instruction
- No minimum of maximum number of students per section
- McMurry will work with UISD depending on the needs per cohort
- Numerical Grades are provided.
- Counselor/Administrator/Adjuncts/Facilitators are granted access to their online portal.



#### Cost Analysis

Students pending TSI ELAR readiness by the end of freshman year will be enrolled based on Counselor/Admin recommendation using their high school and college academic status.

#### Additional Benefits

- McMurry can be used as a supplemental avenue for every cohort.
  - Ex. senior or junior level students pending 1-2 courses are able to enroll asynchronous with the assistance of a UISD facilitator to complete their coursework.
- McMurry may be used to supplement areas of need that Laredo College might not have available for staffing. Ex. Art 1301
- Laredo College will increase their enrollment with students that have achieved college readiness through this partnership.
