RESOLUTION RELATING TO AUTHORIZING THE STATE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL APPLICATION

PROGRAM WHEREAS, The Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Infrastructure Program was established by the Minnesota legislature in 2012 and is defined in Minnesota Statute 174.40. The legislature appropriated funding for SRTS infrastructure projects in 2020 laws, 5th Special Session, Chapter 3, Article 1, Section 16, Subdivision 20 and 2021 laws, 1st Special Session, Article 1, Section 2, Subd. 2 (c); and

WHEREAS, The Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) is responsible for the administration of the State SRTS program and makes the funds available to communities through a competitive process; and

WHEREAS, The Mahtomedi School administration, in partnership with community members and Washington County, are proposing the construction of a walkway along the east side of the drive of the secondary school entrance, leading from the traffic light to existing sidewalks on campus; and

WHEREAS, The funds required to be supplied by the school to complete the project are available and committed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the School Board of ISD832 supports the Safe Routes to School project as presented and authorizes the administration to submit the Safe Routes to School application on behalf of the district.
