School News:

As the New Year begins at Evergreen, the staff has worked relentlessly to implement the new reading curriculum and providing the students with quality instruction. We have monthly PLC's at each grade level to discuss the curriculum, testing, students, and/or flexible grouping to meet the needs of every student. Our school RTI team (Tawnya Campbell/Laura Gill) has been working closely with teachers and assistants in providing valuable professional developments on Fridays around whole group, small group, and intervention/enrichment times for reading. These PD's are on-going and the foundation is around the big fives ideas, which are *phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension*. The other piece to these PD's is sharing the instructional routines from Journeys with all staff. The RTI team continues to get feedback from staff around Journeys to help develop future Professional Developments for our staff. During our 100% meeting in September each grade level team agreed that their priority focus would be phonemic awareness or phonics. We are approaching our 2nd 100% meeting for RTI at the end of January and we are looking forward to the DIBELS data taken this month on individual students. We will use this data to compare it to our 1st 100% meeting that took place in September to see the growth of students in reading and make adjustments to groups to continue to support the needs of every student.

PBIS Assembly Overview:

Here are some pictures of our PBIS assembly that we hold monthly to recognize making good choices and following our PBIS expectations on a consistent basis. Each month, we recognize the students of the month at our assemblies and the EDDA award. We remind students that we need to be doing their best academically and behaviorally.
