Thursday, April 16th 2026

Dear Parents, Families, and Community:

Williams Elementary School will be holding our annual Jog-a-thon for the 2025-2026 school year on **Thursday, April 16th**. This is an important event for Williams Elementary because it funds **Classroom Field Trips, Special Programs, Playground Equipment, Library Books, Learning Supplies, and Materials for all grades**. A sponsor sheet is attached and should be turned in to the office by **Wednesday, April 15th**. More sheets are available in the office if needed. The Jog-a-thon will consist of 1 hour of jogging or walking on an

approximately 1/10 mile path around the school track. Keep in mind the age of the student you are sponsoring when thinking of the number of laps they might cover in that time. Students will most likely jog between 20 and 30 laps during the allotted time. Cold drinks, oranges, and a snack will be provided for all students.

On the day of the Jog-a-thon, students will be provided with a T-shirt. Please make sure your child/children wear appropriate footwear for this day. On **April 20th**, an envelope and a copy of the pledge sheets will be sent home to collect money for each pledge. Donations should be collected and turned in to the office no later than **Monday, May 4th, in order to qualify for student grand prizes**. On **Thursday, May 7th, 2026**, we will have our grand prize assembly. Prizes will be awarded to both individual students and the classes. The class with the most money brought in, averaged out per student, will win the grand prize of an "Abby's Pizza Party."

Our whole school fundraising goal is \$10,000 this year.
