## Attendance Report – Cycle 6 & EOY

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### Board Goal

#### IV. Parent and Community Involvement

In pursuit of excellence, the district will foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students.

### Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the sixth grading cycle (April 21, 2014 – June 5, 2014). Also, the end-of-year attendance for the 2013-2014 school year is also provided.

### Objectives

- District-wide totals based on number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report
- Attendance figures are based on 33 instructional days (sixth cycle)
- Attendance for the school year is based on 174 instructional days

### Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

### Results

- The total attendance percentage for the Denton ISD for Cycle 6 is 95.8%.
- The lowest total attendance average is for 12<sup>th</sup> grade students at 91.7 % followed by EE students at 93.2%
- The highest attendance averages are in the 4th grade, 97.00%
- The district total for 2013-2014 is 96.0%
- 6<sup>th</sup> Cycle Comparison: 2013 – 96.21; 2014 – 95.8%
- EOY Comparison: 2013 – 95.99; 2014 – 96.0%
