We designed a finishing table for the kiddos to custom season their elote to their liking. The kiddos went absolutely bonkers for this!

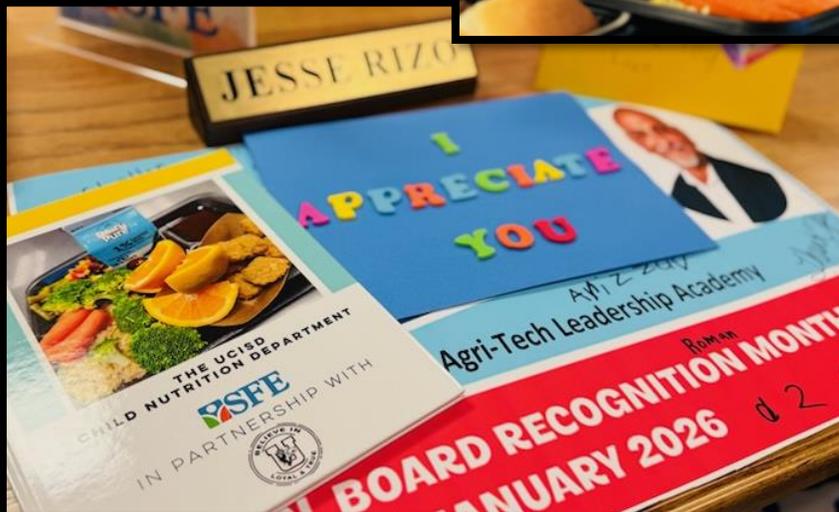
