Union High School is a rural school within the Duchesne County School District located in the northeastern region of Utah. Union High School was opened in 1951 and has a current student population of 1168 students. Union High School offers students the opportunity to enroll in honors and AP courses. Dual Enrollment courses are offered through Utah State University, as well as Career and Technical Education partnering with the Uintah Basin Technical Center (UBTech). Union High School operates on a 5 period A and B schedule offering 10 credits to students per year.

Graduation Requirements for 2022-23:

Students must complete a total of 36 units of credit: Language Arts 4, Math 3, Science 3, Social Studies 3, Physical Education 1.5, Health .5, Financial Literacy .5 CTE 1, Fine Arts 1.5, Digital Studies .5, Elective Courses 17.5. Students 9-12 are required to register for 9 credit units. Seniors, who have sufficient credits to graduate, may enroll in as few courses as needed to graduate.
