The varsity football team had a final roster of 40 players, 23 of which were seniors. They compiled a record of 4-6, with a fourth place finish in district with a 1-3 record. The Lions finished the season as 2018 Bi-District Finalists.

Cross Country Girls

2018 Cross Country Recap:

The Lady Lions had an exceptional year for the 2018 season. The varsity team consisted of seven total runners, including two seasoned seniors, three juniors and two freshman who quickly became top runners for the team. The Varsity and JV Lady Lions finished as the district runner up, only seven points behind first place and advancing to regionals. Competing in one of the toughest regions, at the Regional CC Meet the Lady Lions made a big show out as they were the sixth best team in the region and beat all teams in the district. From regionals, senior Izzy Lawrence and junior Darby Crysler advanced to the State Meet, competing and representing Brownwood very well placing 47 and 67 out of a total of 147 runners

Cross Country Boys

Cross Country Boys Had a rebuilding year. One athlete, Roman McKibben advanced to regionals. We had a total of 12 boys that participated in Cross Country.

Basketball Girls

The high school girls program had a total of 35 players. The varsity team compiled a 18-16 record. The Lady Lions finished as the 3rd seed out of District 7-4A and made the playoffs for the 10th straight season.

The Junior Varsity Lady Lions went 18-7 on the season, finishing as District Champions. The freshmen were 18-2 on the year and finished as District Champions for the second straight year and won two tournament championships.

Individual honors were earned by Mallory Garcia earned TGCA All State and All Region. Matyha Thompson was selected to play in the TGCA All Star Game.

Basketball Boys

This year's varsity finished the season with 22 wins and 11 losses while finishing as district and bi-district champions. The district championship was the first for boys basketball since the 1991-1992 season while the bi-district championship was the first since the 2012 season. This season and last season mark the first time since the early 90's that the boys basketball program has earned back to back 20 win seasons. The varsity team also earned Hamilton Tournament and Texas Bank Holiday Classic championships. The roster consisted of 14 players that earned numerous individual awards.

Junior Zach Strong was named the district Most Valuable Player and to the All Region First Team. Junior John Wilhelm was named the district's Newcomer of the Year while senior George Nicholas was named the district's Sixth Man of the Year. Named to the first team all-district were juniors Adonis McCarty and Isyah Campos while juniors Cooper Swanzy and Theo Bryant were named to the second team and senior Ryan Riker was named to the Honorable Mention team. Eight players were named to the Academic All-District Team while Ryan Riker was named to the Texas Association of Basketball Coaches Academic All-State Team.

This year's JV team finished with a record of 20 wins and 5 losses with the roster consisting of 13 players.

The freshman team finished with a record of 7 wins and 15 losses with their roster consisting of 12 players.

The boys had a successful season, competing in four meets leading up to the regional meet. Twelve different boys competed in at least one meet, with most competing in at least three. As a team we had top 5 finishes at the Burnet and Lampasas invitational meets. We had four lifters qualify for the regional meet, with Theo Bryant placing 4th.

The girls team had a total of two lifters, both of whom qualified for the regional meet. Alyssa Preston broke the regional meet record in the dead lift and placed 2nd overall, qualifying for the state meet where she placed 6th. We only had one senior, so we look forward to having a great year next year.

Golf Girls

We had six girls play golf. The girls were district runnerup finishing one stroke behind Glen Rose. Three of the girls were on the all district team (top ten), Mallory Garcia was the district Champ, Bryanna Galvan was 4th and Abbi Galvan was 9th.

Regionals the girls finished in 7th with PR team scores and they beat Glen Rose! Mallory finished 3rd overall and 1st to advance to state. It was a great surprise! State tournament was held in Kyle and Mallory finished in 15th.

Golf Boys

The boys' golf team had 9 participants-5 Varsity, 4 Junior Varsity. The Varsity Team won the District Golf Tournament by 34 strokes. Caden Reagan and Jaryn Pruitt tied for first place after regulation play was complete. Caden and Jaryn went on to a playoff to determine the District Medalist, with Caden winning the Championship after a 5 hole playoff.

The Varsity Team qualified for the Regional Tournament in Lubbock. Jaryn Pruitt qualified for the State Tournament as an Individual Medalist.

Boys Track

The boys track team had a very successful year. We had 33 boys combined participating on our varsity and junior varsity teams. Our varsity team won the Angelo State Relays and finished in the top 5 in three other invitational meets. Our varsity team won the district championship and placed 3rd at the area championship.

We had seven boys qualify for the regional meet and won the regional championship. Five athletes qualified for state in seven different events. The 4x100 team of Royshad Henderson, Braden Jetton, Khyren Deal, and AJ McCarty placed 5th while the same four runners placed 4th in 4x200. AJ placed 1st in Triple Jump and 5th in Long Jump, Braden placed 4th in the 200, and Tommy Bowden placed 4th in the 110 High Hurdles and 7th in the 300 Low Hurdles. The team placed 4th at the State Meet.

Overall, we had a great track season. Our boys competed hard every single time they stepped on the track and represented Brownwood very well. We graduated some great kids that will be hard to replace, but we have a good group returning to compete next year, along with a strong incoming freshman class that won district as 8th graders.
