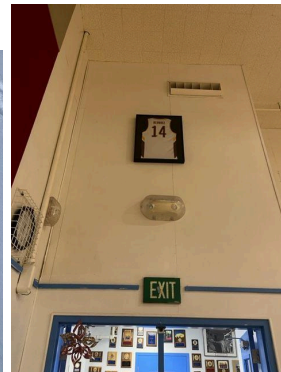
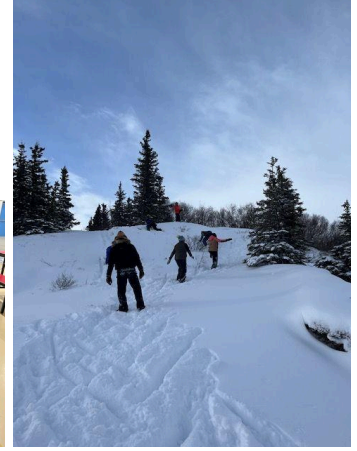
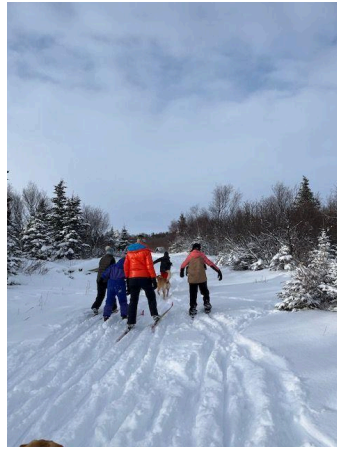

Outstanding Activities and Events

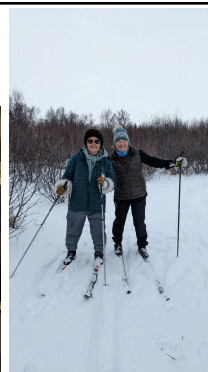

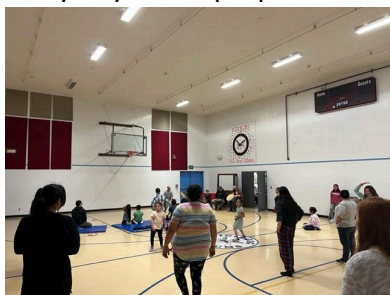
Personnel
