Roosevelt Junior High School is a rural school within the Duchesne County School District, located in the northeastern region of Utah. Roosevelt Junior High School was opened in 2007. Graduation Requirements for 2022-23:

Students must complete a total of 36 units of credit: Language Arts 4, Math 3, Science 3, Social Studies 3, Physical Education 1.5, Health .5, Financial Literacy .5 CTE 1, Fine Arts 1.5, Digital Studies .5, Elective Courses 17.5. Students 9-12 are required to register for 9 credit units. Seniors, who have sufficient credits to graduate, may enroll in as few courses as needed to graduate.

College and Career Readiness:

College and Career Awareness courses are required during 7th grade which include Business and Family and Consumer Science. 7th grade students participate in a college and career readiness lesson taught by the counselors. They also get the opportunity to participate in Reality Town, which is a hands-on experience where students learn the reality of adulthood by making lifestyle and budget decisions. 7th and 8th grade students have the opportunity to enroll in more career and technical courses as electives. All 8th grade students meet individually with counselors to discuss their college and career goals. Their guardians are encouraged to attend. 7th and 8th grade students also get to spend a day at the career fair learning from community professionals about their career.
