

Cell Phone Policy - OHS Student Handbook:

Cell phones are not allowed to be out in classrooms at Owatonna High School. When the bell rings, cell phones and personal electronic devices (smart watches, personal laptops) must be secured inside a backpack or student locker. Further, cell phones or any recording device are not allowed to be used in restrooms or locker rooms at any time. A student not following these guidelines will be subject to the following consequences:

1st Offense: Cell phone/device will be given to the teacher. The teacher will notify home and the phone/device may be picked up by the student from an administrator at the end of the school day. (Refusal will result in 2nd offense)

2nd Offense: Student will be sent or escorted to the office and administration will hold the phone/device. Parent/guardian will be allowed to pick up the phone/device at the end of the school day.

3rd Offense: Student will be sent to the office and administration will hold the phone/device daily for 10 school days.

Any further offenses will result in the student not being able to bring a device into the school. Note: Disabling a cell phone or computer to thwart an investigation of a disciplinary matter will result in disciplinary action. Designated health plans will be followed to allow for student health and safety.
