CEMS MAP Testing

- The Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) spring assessments are being administered in second through eighth grades.
- All grades from second through eighth, MAP Tested the week of May 17^h. Students participating in MAP Testing were tested in both Reading and Mathematics. MAP Results will be mailed home to parents/guardians with Quarter 4 report cards.

CMS PEAKS State Assessments/Updates

- CMS students in grades 6-8 were scheduled to participate in PEAKS Testing on Tuesday, May 4th (ELA), Wednesday, May 5th (MA), and Thursday, May 6th (SCI/8th only). However, CCSD transitioned to the Red/High Risk Scenario as per CCSD's Smart Start to School Plan, and moved all schools to distance learning the week before (4/26 - 4/30/21) the CMS was scheduled to administer PEAKS Assessments. Given the transition, coupled with the disruption to instruction, along with the amount of student absences the CMS experienced following the closure, the CMS was not able to complete PEAKS Testing as originally scheduled and planned.
- As per Superintendent Reitan, our District Testing Coordinator, Ms. Melissa Peavey, and I informed the Statewide Assessment Department of this matter and completed the necessary paperwork with the PEAKS Assessment Coordinator, Ms. Kari Quinto.

CES Sea Weeks/Updates

- Given CCSD's school closure the week of April 26th (4/26 - 4/30/21) was also one of the CES's Sea Weeks, previously scheduled and planned sea week activities could not be carried out as originally planned.
- Thankfully, the week of May 24th (5/24 - 5/28/21) also brings us low tides; therefore, please expect CES Sea Week activities to be planned during that week now.
- As referenced in my April report, teachers will begin their CES Sea Week activities a review of beach etiquette in individual classrooms. Ms. Melissa Peavey will be available to support teachers as they cover beach etiquette with their students. In addition, CES Teachers will follow CCSD's Smart Start to School Guidelines and will mitigate CES Sea Week activities accordingly.
