Operational Impact

An approximate cost of training, materials, and stipends each summer has been \$14,000. Funding has been provided through sources such as Title II, DISD Foundation, and campus funds.

Results

CHAMPS is a positive student management system that is used in all elementary and middle schools excepting Blanton. The intent is to assist with creating more responsible learning environments through systematic voice levels, participation, and activity awareness. A recent survey of all participating schools yielded results that positive changes have been made with student behaviors because of CHAMPS being initiated into our schools.
