The Mahtomedi Public Schools will follow the District #832 Curriculum Cycles as it implements the Minnesota and district academic standards. This document ensures that all students will receive instruction, curriculum and assessment, which will complete the state and district academic standards in all disciplines. Technology will be integrated across all disciplines. When the Minnesota Department of Education adopts new standards in a subject area, that subject area will be given a two year review to align curriculum to the new standards. Subject areas will be granted a one year review when standards have not changed. A one year curriculum review will be used to evaluate alignment of standards and curriculum, review common assessments, and complete curriculum mapping.
