









Committee Responsibilities

1.) periodically provide recommendations to the district's board of trustees and district administrators regarding updating the district multihazard emergency operations plan and submit recommendation(s) on school safety audits every three years to the school board and school administration.
2.) consult with local law enforcement apencies on methods to increase law enforcement presence near district campuses; and
3.) meet at least once during each cademic semester and at least once during the summer. A committee established by a school district that operates schools on a year-round system or in accordance with another alternative schedule shall meet at least three times during each calendar year, with an internal of at least two months between each meeting.

- A.) To review each report required to be submitted by the district to the Texas School Safety Center. (The TxSSC has established a compliance division entitled "School Safety Readiness Division.")
- The committee is subject to Chapter 551, Government Code, and may meet in executive session as provided by that chapter. Notice of a committee meeting must be posted in the same manner as notice of a meeting of the districts board of trustees.
