## *From the Principal*

**Dear Parents and Guardians,**

We are excited to share positive news as we begin the second half of the school year. Our winter MAP testing—the second round of benchmark assessments for the year—is now complete, and the results show meaningful academic growth across our school.

In mathematics, our fall data placed us at the 38th percentile as a school. After December testing, we are proud to report that we have moved up to the 68th percentile. This reflects significant progress and speaks to the hard work of our students, teachers, and support staff.

In reading, we also saw growth. As a school, we moved from the 59th percentile in the fall to the 61st percentile in the winter. While this increase is more modest, it represents continued forward movement and helps guide our instructional focus moving into the spring.

These results help us celebrate successes, while also identifying areas where we can continue to grow. Teachers will use this data to adjust instruction, provide targeted support, and challenge students at all levels.

Our annual Day of Service is set for May 15, 2026. This special middle school tradition brings our entire school community—students and staff—together to give back through service projects across our local communities, from Bay City to Manzanita.

Please mark your calendars for this meaningful day. If you are willing to volunteer or help support our Day of Service, we would love to hear from you—please give the school office a call.

We look forward to a strong and successful second half of the school year!

### Reminders

Neah-Kah-Nie Middle School is a cellphone and smartwatch-free building. Upon enrollment, all students are issued a Yondr pouch to safely secure their electronic device(s) during school hours.

Students are responsible for bringing their Yondr pouch to school every day. If students forget their Yondr pouch, they are to turn their phone or watch in to the front office for the school day.



The Yondr pouch is the property of the Neah-Kah-Nie School District and will be checked out to each student just like a textbook or Chromebook, and each student will be responsible for its condition. If a student damages their Pouch, a \$25.00 fee will be assessed for the replacement of the Pouch.


## From the Nurse

Oregon Exclusion date for all students is Feb 25th 2026.

If your student is due for an immunization, you should have received a letter in the mail stating what vaccine is due.


#### Why is it important to keep copies of immunization records?
