

Tech Meeting: 10/11/17

Continuing PD Opportunities: Keep putting out information for staff; Try to find some easily digestible amount of information for other staff members; It can be websites, apps, complexities of IC, etc. Write article for email, newsletter instead of teaching our peers,

They can't improve it if we don't tell them; We aren't done with the construction yet so it is okay to share what isn't working; We should notice an improved speed when we are working; Cameras are still being worked on--there are 83 cameras on campus;

IC: Parents: Paul sets them up directly and then emails them. The offices can do it too; Heather and Sarah created a simple how to for the MS students; They will share that with the HS;
