



Teacher Student Success Act 2022 - 2023 Goals, Plan, Budget

At Duchesne Elementary School we “Expect Excellence.” We are working to ensure this high goal in all areas of a student’s education; this includes their social and emotional learning.

One goal for the 2022-2023 school year at DES is to continue to use Second Step with fidelity in all grades K-6. Second Step helps our students to acquire and effectively apply the knowledge, attitudes, and skills to understand and manage emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions. I track the success of the program by the number of major issues that we have. The number this school year has decreased by 6 students.

Students also need to learn how to manage their own emotions and behavior. One way of doing this is through the continued use of a school wide “Wellness Center” as well as areas in classrooms. This will give the students the opportunity to take a few minutes to disconnect from the stressful situation they are in, relax, recover and continue their learning in a better frame of mind. This is measured by the number of repeat students using the wellness room. We look for patters and address them with our school social worker and students success coach.

Our teachers strive to provide excellent instruction and interventions to our students. In order to do this our teachers need help with interventions. A portion of the budget will be se aside to pay for intervention aides to help our students get extra help.

Janis Taylor organizes and runs our Title I program at DES. In order to do this she need to make many management decisions and work with schedules. DES is going to provide Ms. Taylor with a stipend to compensate her for her leadership responsibilities.

Our plan to reach these goals for our students include the following strategies:

- 1: Continue to use Second Step in all grade levels. This means purchasing a yearly *online* subscription for 6th grade.
- 2: Items for Wellness room and an aide to supervise the room
- 3: Provide a \$2,000 stipend for Title I leadership responsibilities.
- 4: We would also like to provide additional money to extend instructional aide hours to provide more help to our struggling students.
