### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

### **Building and Sites**

Mrs. Botwinski reported that there was an update on the Ross/Sullivan Garden project. The Boy Scouts, led by Eagle Scout candidate Gavin Salefski, assembled and placed the garden boxes donated in full by the PTO. Also there was an update on the electrical install in the Ross/Sullivan MP room for food service equipment. Low Voltage Wiring has completed their project, on replacement of network cabling at MacArthur and Grodsky. Also, there was discussion on the door intercom replacements for Sullivan and Grodsky and two proposals were discussed. The current systems are obsolete and will need to be replaced. An update was provided on the concrete and paving summer projects. There was an extensive review provided on all the custodial summer work.

#### **NSSEO**

Mrs. Botwinski reported that there is a plan to move forward with the two tiered structure of governance. The current Governing Board has one elected board member from each of the member district boards, as well as an Operational Board composed of the NSSEO Superintendent and the superintendents of each member district. Governing Board members will be bringing information back to their home districts regarding next steps. "Shine From Within" will be the theme for this school year. A new staff orientation day was held at Sunrise Lake Outdoor Education Center. The Kirk HVAC project is expected to be completed by the start of the school year.

Dr. Schnoor has a new contract and will retire in two years when the contract ends. New policies were approved. Molly Dunn approved PD for the staff. The board presented new committee assignments. An edited

version of the articles of agreement was presented as well as an update on the strategic plan. **POLICY** There was discussion on the Policy Updates from Press Policy 119.
