## **Executive Session**

An Executive Session (closed meeting) is only permitted for the Board discussion of items that are exceptions listed in the Texas Open Meetings Act. Trustees may not take action during the Executive Session. An agenda item on the regular agenda provides the Board the opportunity to openly discuss and take action on any items discussed in Executive Session. Items permitted in this closed session include:

- Consultation with School Attorney on any agenda item, pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offer or other specified topics;
- Deliberation about purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property;
- Deliberation on a prospective gift or donation to the District;
- Deliberation regarding safety and security;
- Deliberation regarding economic development negotiations;
- Deliberation of personnel matters to include the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee or to hear a complaint of charge against an officer or employee;

## **School Board Meeting**

Aledo ISD Board Meetings are held the third Monday of each month. The meetings begin at 7:00 p.m. In the Aledo ISD Board Room. All meetings are open to the public. The agenda for each meeting is posted at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to the meeting at Aledo ISD and also on the District's web site at [aledoschoolfusion.us](http://aledoschoolfusion.us)

## **Special Presentation**

This time is allocated during each meeting for students or staff to be recognized for an award or honor.

## **Public Comment**

The Board Agenda has a specified time during each meeting for public comments. This is a time designated for citizens to address the Trustees on a subject pertaining to the Trustee's jurisdiction/responsibility. The Texas Open Meetings Act prohibits

deliberation by the Trustees of any subject which is not on the posted agenda, therefore the Board will not be able to discuss or take action on items brought up during the citizen's presentation. The Board may have the subject placed on an agenda for a future meeting or, if appropriate, have staff respond to your concerns.

### **How to speak before the Board during Public Comments:**

1. Citizens wishing to speak during this time must complete a Public Meeting Appearance sheet. The sheets are located on the counter when you first enter the Board Room.
2. Once the form is completed, it must be turned into the District Secretary prior to the start of the Board Meeting.
3. Each speaker is asked to state his/her name and address for the official record.
4. Each speaker is allowed three (3) minutes to speak on the subject item. If one speaker is representing a group of 10 or more, that speaker will be allowed to speak for ten (10) minutes. There is a cumulative total of thirty (30) minutes for all speakers.
5. All public comments should be addressed to the Superintendent and Trustees. Profanity or abusive language directed to, or about, any Board Member or staff will not be tolerated. No member of the public shall be permitted to make verbal, personal attacks on the Superintendent, Board Members, or District Staff. Any such verbal attack or attempted attack may be challenged with a point of order, or the Board President may interrupt an offending speaker to enforce this rule.

### **Consent Agenda**

Consent Agenda items are routine items deemed to require little or no deliberation by the Board therefore they are considered collectively. Board Members can remove any item from the Consent Agenda and consider it separately from the collective list.

## Local Governance

The Aledo ISD School Board is composed of seven (7) Board members.

The Board is elected at-large and serve three-year terms. Under the provisions of Board policy and subject only to the limitations imposed by the Texas Constitution, State Law and Federal Law, the Board enacts local policy, adopts the annual operating budget, and sets policy.

The Superintendent is responsible for the day-to-day operations of the Aledo ISD and reports directly to the Board.
