1. MVSEC Coordinator Program Updates

- VI-planning compensatory services; VI on maternity leave Feb-May; PT came back 1 week early; 10 new VI students since August
- New Pathways at 62 enrollment-stable even with move-ins and move-outs; need to consider of EC viability; please let us know if EC will be coming within the year
- SAIL-pretty stable enrollment; most AR are earlier in the year and few left by February; schools speaking to SAIL to ascertain appropriateness; space will be an issue at Shelby; WCC always a concern for loss of space/cost; how would a child not be successful at SAIL? a student who was going to be a liability in the community; no nurse on staff but one student with Nurse aide; ABLE program students will typically transition to SAIL

2. Driver's Ed requests from Marianjoy; obligation

- D303 getting special requests for DE evaluations, especially for t=students with autism and ED
- Geneva and Batavia students pay fee at HS, so district pays for evaluation and parent will pay for class
- DE is not a graduation requirement, but a significant life skill
- If school offers DE for typical students and evaluation determines student can take class at HS versus special
- Include DE teachers in determining if special evaluation is warranted
- What are Marianjoy's parameters for evaluation

3. ELA curricular resources elementary – HS

- D303 looking for additional resources in the area of math-focus to have students develop skills versus modifying algebra 1; student missing out and focus needs to be on skill acquisition versus passing the class
- Looking at Vmath, Inside Algebra,
- Carnegie Math-blended; Front Row-online; Happy Numbers-online
- Harder to find HS resources
- Read 180; Step Up for writing;
- Shared districts' curricular options
- Does any district guidance on how decisions are made as to which students are recommended for co-teaching
- Trend to have IEP goals based on passing class versus skill deficit
- Central will share document they created of minutes per week per skill
- RTI and special education: special education student is eligible for reading comprehension. However, they can also receive RTI services for fluency because not eligible under this deficit

- Develop a cross-district document for us to improve services
- 4. OT/PT for 2018-2019**
 - Batavia, Geneva, Kaneland, St. Charles, Central-status quo for next year
- 5. Projections**
 - February 5th district projections due to MV
 - Sending out to district by 1/30
- 6. CLASS/EC New Pathways Program**
 - Central and Kaneland looking at options
 - Linda needs to work directly with school districts
 - Can request a deviation from state-let's meet to discuss
- 7. ALOP for 2018-2019**
 - Geneva hope to keep teacher
 - Can district tap into fund balance? Apply to district tuition
 - MVSEC needs direction from districts-next Finance committee meeting
- 8. ISTAR**
 - Districts cannot have access to all MV
 - Districts will continue to add students
 - MVSEC will adjust program portions including dates (SAIL and 12+ start date variations)
 - Delivered transportation invoices to all districts, based on per person use
