SUGGESTED SCHOOL BOARD ACTION:

Recommend approval.

DESCRIPTION:

As presented at the March 11th board workshop in the K-5 math Curriculum Adoption Proposal (CAP) report, the Math Learning Center’s Bridges program is recommended for approval as the core resource for K-5 math instruction, beginning in the 2024-2025 school year.

Preliminary budget figures are listed below.

<u>Program</u>	<u>Budget Request</u>
K-5 • Year 1 Cost	\$ 259,188
Estimated annual cost for student books	\$ 40,000

Over the adoption cycle of approximately nine years, the total cost for the elementary math curriculum adoption is estimated at \$579,188.

The K-5 Math CAP Report was presented to the District Teaching & Learning Council on Thursday, February 29, 2024 and the Community Teaching & Learning Councils on Friday, March 1, 2024. The report was then presented to the school board on March 11, 2024.

Upon board approval, Teaching & Learning will begin formal steps to plan for implementation in 2024-2025.
