Observations:

- 5 students with one incident
- 11 of 13 students on IEP
- 7 students with multiple incidents
- 1 student had 9 incidents
- Incidents generally happen in succession
- Lots of kicking, hitting, throwing, biting
- Running is the other "class" of behaviors prompting restraint, generally with younger students

Positives:

- Number of incidents is down from last year, which totaled 33 and did not include Serendipity
- Staff use strategies to bring calm and use proper protocol from training

Concerns:

- Unreported incidents
- Reoccuring incidents
- Incomplete forms
- Consistent reporting from outside placements
