Outstanding Activities and Events

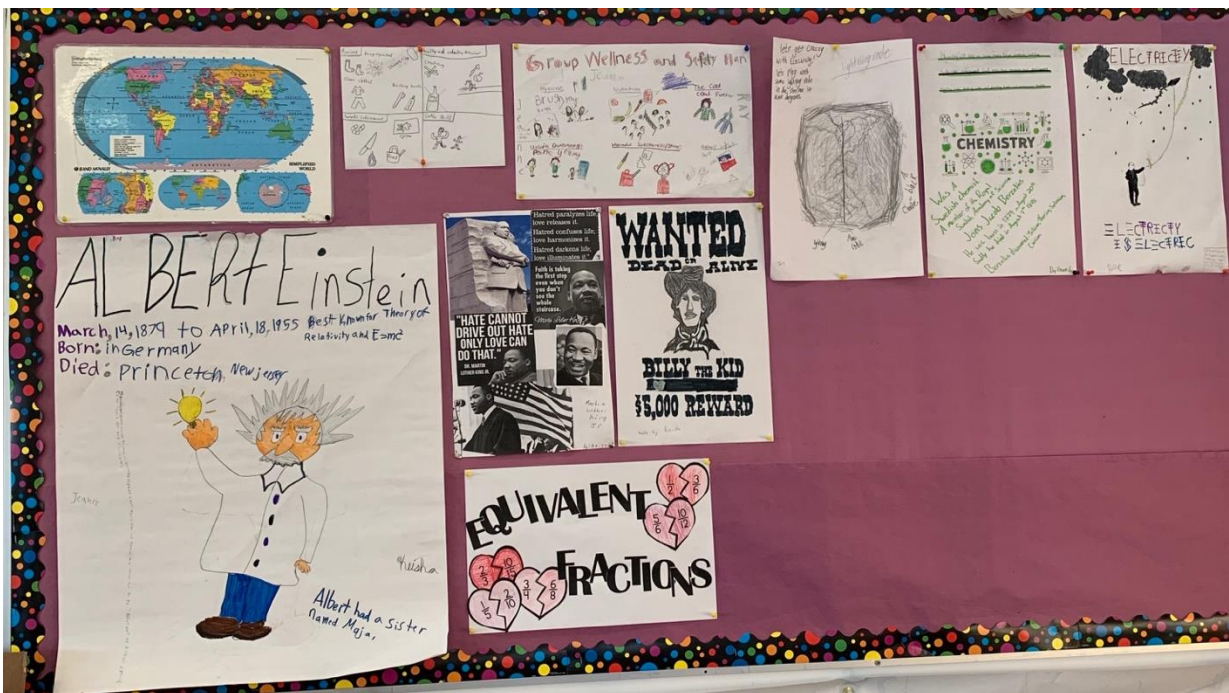
