

Interlocal Agreement with Education Service Center, Region 20
PACE Purchasing Cooperative

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of a resolution to join and participate in the PACE Purchasing Cooperative being organized and administered by the Education Service Center, Region 20.

BOARD GOAL:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:
